AHCMOM213 - Operate and maintain chainsaws

This training program teaches candidates the skills and knowledge required to safely operate hand-held chainsaws and maintain them in working condition. This course includes cross-cutting fallen timber using safe cutting techniques.

Candidates will learn how to:

Assist in the preparation of work site by

- + Understanding first aid, emergency personnel, equipment, and procedural requirements
- + Confirming and monitoring work zones with work crew
- + Identifying hazards and implementing controls including environmental and traffic control measures

Check, prepare and store chainsaws by

- + Selecting and using appropriate tools and materials to maintain chainsaws
- + Calculating and mixing fuels/oils using ratios

Operate chainsaw by

- + Following Personal Protective Equipment requirements
- + Evaluating materials and using appropriate supports
- + Learning how to appropriately use and operate chainsaws

Clean up chainsaw and work area and complete records by

- + Safely disposing debris in line with requirements
- + Cleaning and storing chainsaws
- + Understanding requirements for maintaining workplace documents and reporting incidents/damage
