CPCWHS1001 - Prepare to work safely in the construction industry (WHITE CARD)

Under National Health and Safety laws, any person doing construction work in Australia must have successfully completed a general WHS construction induction course for the industry before they start work in any construction activity. Construction activities include housing construction, civil construction, renovations, repairs, refurbishment, asbestos removal, carpentry, bricklaying, concreting, plumbing and roof, floor and wall tiling.

This reform is the latest initiative of a larger program to harmonise workplace health and safety systems between states and territories and is in addition to mutual recognition of the construction induction cards obtained in other states and territories.
