



Confined Space Operations

Description:

This course is delivered in accordance with the Work Health and Safety Act. It covers legislative requirements, duties of personnel, confined space identification, risk assessment, entry procedures, documentation, emergency procedures, atmospheric monitoring with gas detectors and the practical use of entry equipment.

Suitable for:

Confined space entrants and stand-by persons who work in and around confined spaces. Accountable persons or those responsible for managing confined spaces, issuing permits or assessing confined space risks should also complete a Confined Space Management Course.

Duration and costs per person:

Full course - 1 day \$280.00 Starts at 8.30 am – 4.00 pm approx. unless advised differently

Refresher – 4 hours \$190.00 Starts at 8.30 am – 1.00 pm approx. unless advised differently

Pre-Requisites: Nil for full course. Previous qualification or ticket for refresher course. Previous qualification and significant, recent experience for re-accreditation.

Participant Requirements:

Parts of this course are conducted outdoors. Wear or bring clothing and PPE that you know will keep you protected from the sun and the prevailing weather of the day. Hi-visibility clothing and other PPE may also be mandatory at your workplace – If so, wear it accordingly.

Wear or bring clothing that can get dusty. You will wear harnesses and use confined space equipment to enter real or simulated confined spaces.

Assessment:

A short theory assessment is conducted at the end of the day. Practical skills and procedures are assessed during the practical activities.

Outcome:

A Statement of Attainment (in the form of a wallet sized card) is issued for:

- MSMPER202 Observe permit work
- MSMPER200 Work in accordance with an issued permit
- MSMPER205 Enter confined space
