

## Licence to Operate a Forklift Hobart TAS

**COURSE CODE:** FLIFTTAS

**DURATION TIMES:** 2 days, 8am until approximately 4pm  
This comprises face-to-face classroom learning, with practical training and assessment undertaken in a simulated work environment.

**PARTICIPANTS:** Minimum 4 — Maximum 6  
This course is based on the requirements of the National Standard for Licensing Persons Performing High Risk Work and in its current form meets State and Territory licensing requirements.

**Application for a High Risk Work Licence (LF) must be made of WorkSafe TAS within 60 days of successful completion.**

**DRESS REQUIREMENTS:** Personal Protective Equipment is required:

- Safety boots
- Yellow high visibility clothing consisting of long sleeves and long trousers
- Hard hat
- Safety glasses
- Gloves

**OTHER REQUIREMENTS:** The ability to read and correctly interpret complex signage; speak clearly and unambiguously in English; and to explain, describe and verify sometimes complex needs and issues. Writing is required to the level of completing workplace forms.

**Participants must be at least 18 years of age and provide 100 points of identification. If you do not hold TAS-issued photo ID, you must notify Coates Training prior to enrolment.**

**OUTCOME:** A Statement of Attainment for the following unit:

### OUTLINE:

- Compliance with WHS licensing legislation
- Communication and working safely with others in the work area
- Identify hazards associated with the operation of the forklift truck and put in place effective hazard controls for those hazards identified
- Conduct pre-start up, operational, moving loads and shut down and secure checks of the forklift truck, according to procedures
- Operate the forklift truck and move loads safely, including driving and manoeuvring, picking up and placing of loads at various stack heights
- Drive forklift truck with load in forward and reverse, maintaining visibility

- Problem solving activities
- Problem solving questions—written
- Short answer questions - written
- Group participation
- Work type activities
- Observation of practical skills
- Completion of National Assessment Instrument for High Risk Licensing

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
