Theory session

The theory session is delivered in a format that encourages engagement from all participants.

A written assessment is completed during the theory session.

Practical session

- Practical exercises are designed to encourage safe driving both on and off road. If a suitable area is available this will include emergency braking on gravel roads.
- Practical components are flexible and are adjusted to meet drivers' experience levels and vehicle types and includes discussion on all modern safety and 4WD systems.
- Terrain negotiation over a variety of obstacles. Drivers will gain experience in operating in the different 4WD modes and understand how best to manage the 4WD off road.
- Programs include basic recovery/vehicle extraction. Please advise us prior to training the recovery equipment your drivers carry.

All training participants receive a certificate of completion electronically.
