Building in Bushfire

What this course is about

Building in Bushfire: a look at the requirements for designing and building in bushfire prone areas with a focus on common questions and problems.

This course provides an understanding of the requirements for designing and building in bushfireprone areas. Participants will learn how to identify the bushfire attack level, interpret plans and reports, and comply with relevant legislation and standards. In addition, the course covers commonly asked questions and provides practical guidance on designing and constructing compliant buildings. On successful completion of this course, participants will have the skills and knowledge necessary to confidently design and build in bushfire-prone areas, while factoring in statutory requirements.

What should I know beforehand?

Those entering this course must be able to demonstrate broad industry knowledge and experience, and may include, but is not limited to, holding a relevant industry qualification.

Optimus strongly recommends attendees possess the following skills:

- A basic understanding of the different roles within the construction industry.
- A reasonable level of language, literacy, and numeracy skills.
- The ability to interpret basic construction plans.

How much work will there be?

This course is a short course and attendees should allow 4.5 hours, inclusive of breaks. Many factors can affect the amount of training required, including number and experience of attendees.

While it is expected that you will finish the Building in Bushfire course on your first attempt, you can request extensions or retake the course if necessary. Additionally, you have the option to complete the course ahead of schedule.

How, when, and where?

Below outlines the delivery schedule for the training.

- **Course Duration:** 4.5 hours including breaks

What do I need to bring?

Activities

• Attendees are provided with resources to complete activities which will form the final section of the course. These will be group-based activities and require group discussion to complete.

Questions and answers

• Throughout the session, your trainer will encourage group discussion where questions will be raised, and the attendee will be given the opportunity to demonstrate they have gained the required knowledge and understanding.

How much does it cost?
