The SLSM program develops the leadership & collaboration skills needed to effectively plan, execute, monitor and deliver work safely and efficiently.

The program builds the leadership capabilities needed for individuals and teams to collaborate effectively to exercise shared responsibility for safety. Over 11 weeks, participants explore proven practical tools, frameworks and techniques that for over a decade have generated significant safety and performance improvements globally in hazardous operations.

Online delivery ensures learners stay connected to their work context and engage in work place actions that drive tangible outcomes. Content is delivered through 3 hours of learning each week comprising reading, interactive lectures, tutorials, and 1:1 interactions with a dedicated facilitator. A recent survey of one of our programs revealed the following participant responses, which are typical across all our programs:

93% were actively engaged throughout the program.

86% had successfully implemented new learnings.

73% stated it was the best leadership program they had attended.



Program Content →

The program has 3 separate components.

Part 1: Human Performance in Action

- → Understanding the gap between work as imagined and work as done
- → Using hazard hunts and reviews to develop safe systems of work
- → Planning work safely using a collaborative planning process
- → Executing mindfully while balancing task focus and situational awareness
- → Balancing speed and quality without compromising safety
- → Using 'safe holds/stop the job' triggers and knowing how to safely restart work

Part 2: Safe Supervision in Practice

- → Learning how to create psychological safety to harness diversity and create shared responsibility for safety
- → Clarifying accountability and authority while aligning roles and goals to engage teams in collaborative planning
- → Balancing task focus and situational awareness by using training, mentoring and coaching to improve the safety of work
- → Engaging the team in after action debriefs so that learning leads to actions that drive continuous improvement

Part 3: Personal Capstone Project

- → Synthesising the key learnings from the program to create Know, Say, Do performance goals
- → Developing and implementing a safety improvement initiative that solves a current work issue by using some of the programs tools, frameworks and techniques
