The TC1 skill set addresses the skills and knowledge required for those responsible for traffic control on Temporary Traffic Management Category 1 environments as described in the Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management.

- Hold a white card which must be obtained prior to the course (CPCWHS1001 or equivalent).
