The TC2 skill set addresses the skills and knowledge required for those responsible for traffic control on Temporary Traffic Management Category 2 environments as described in the Austroads Guide to Temporary Traffic Management.

Participants will learn how to manage traffic on high-volume roads, operate communication devices for clear and efficient communication, and control traffic at traffic signals where signals have been turned off. Additionally, participants will gain knowledge in conducting essential housekeeping activities to maintain safe and organized work environments throughout their tasks.

Course Requirements

- LLN level 2 or above (not required if previously completed with CivilEdge).
- Hold a white card which must be obtained prior to the course (CPCWHS1001 or equivalent). Completion of TC 1 - 'RIISS00058 - Traffic Controller 1'.
- Min. 40 hours of experience working in a TTM workplace in a traffic controller role (e.g. job tickets / letter from employer).
