## **Training Course Outline**

#### **Elevated Work Platform**

TLILIC0005 Licence to operate a boom-type elevating work platform (boom length 11 metres or more)

**RIIRTM203E** Work as a safety observer/spotter **RIIHAN301E** Operate elevating work platform

This training program teaches candidates the skills and knowledge required to safely operate a boom-type Elevating Work Platform (EWP) where the length of the boom is 11 metres or more in accordance with legislation.

In this course a boom-type elevating work platform is defined as a telescoping device, hinged device, articulated device, or any combination of these, that is used to support a platform which elevates personnel, equipment, or materials.

Candidates will learn how to:

#### Plan EWP operations work by,

- Identifying workplace hazards and control measures
- Selecting appropriate EWP according to workplace conditions and tasks
- Developing effective communication skills
- Using safety equipment correctly

#### Conduct routine checks by,

- Interpreting signs and labels
- Confirming sign visibility
- Conducting pre-start operational and visibility checks
- Correctly setting up EWP

### Safely operate EWP by,

- Assessing safe limits to comply with EWP data plate specifications
- Managing hazards and stabilising EWP
- Responding to incidents and unsafe conditions

#### Work as a safety observer/spotter by,

- Directing and managing vehicle and pedestrian traffic
- Communicating using hand signals and radios
- Implementing no-go and exclusion zones

#### Shut down and secure EWP by,

- Preventing unauthorised access and parking EWP appropriately
- Following EWP shut down procedures
- Conducting checks after EWP operation

Candidates are required to successfully complete a theory and practical component to obtain a Statement of Attainment.
