CPCCWHS1001 - PREPARE TO WORK SAFELY IN THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY (WHITE CARD)

Overview:

This unit of competency specifies the mandatory Work Health and Safety training required prior to undertaking construction work.

This unit will enable the participant to demonstrate a full awareness and knowledge of health and safety legislative requirements, to work safely and prevent injury or harm to self and others. It covers identifying and orally reporting common construction hazards, understanding basic risk control measures, and identifying procedures for responding to potential incidents and emergencies. It also ensures that participants are able to correctly select and fitting common personal protective equipment (PPE) used for construction work.
